3. The Event

Venue – Whites Road.

Length – 2km of gravel private road, which has just been graded and re-gravelled

Scrutineering / Documentation

Competitor Requirements – Drivers must hold as a minimum a MSNZ **M** licence (ClubSport). Passengers must sign passenger declaration form. Be aware of new safety clothing requirements. Passengers allowed in cars with suitable roll cages, safety harness and wearing appropriate safety gear (overalls and helmet) at the DISCRETION OF THE CLERK OF COUSE.

Competition – The event will start with an Indian file followed by 4 official runs with your fastest run counting towards your result. Provision is available for two driver cars.

This event will run under the COVID-19 Protection Framework and the MotorSport NZ ‘Back in Motion’ guidelines.

The Otago region is under “Red” at the time of publishing. Anyone intending on attending the event must be able to show their valid “My Vaccine Pass” upon request.

In-line with the COVID-19 Protection Framework, all Events require face masks to be worn at all times except for when the Crew is in their Competition Vehicle.

4. Entries

These are now open and will close with the end of documentation on the day of the event.

Entries will be limited to 50

Acceptance will be at the Clerk of the Course’s discretion.

Event organisers reserve the right to refuse any entry in accordance with the prescribed provisions of the National Sporting Code.

Entries are now open to be done online.
