



The 'Catlins Inn' Rallysprint 2021

Supplementary Regulations

1. Jurisdiction

This event is a Rallysprint promoted by the South Otago Car Club Inc. and will take place on Sunday 15th August 2021 at Puaho Road, just north of Papatowai in the Catlins.

It will be held under Motorsport New Zealand's National Sporting Code and its appendices and schedules, particularly;

Appendix 5, Schedule RS for the Rallysprint and

Appendix 2, Schedule A or AA for Vehicle and Driver Requirements.

Roll Protection is Mandatory.

3. The Event

Venue – The event will be held on Puaho Road, to the left of the McLennan Bridge just before Papatowai on the Papatowai Highway; 23.4km from Owaka, and the Rallysprint will start on Puaho Road GPS Lat S46.54441 – Long E169.47800 ; turning left at the intersection of Puaho and Purakauiti School Road, and turning left at the intersection of Purakauiti School Road and Burnt Flat Road (Map attached). Cars will finish 2km from the end of Burnt Flat Road and tour to the Papatowai Highway then left on Papatowai Highway for 6km to the event start line on Puaho Road. Total touring distance is 8km.

Length –9.9km of public gravel road.

Scrutineering / Documentation

Owaka Motors – Sunday 15th August 2021, 8.30am – 10.00am PLEASE BE PROMPT. Cars and service vehicles will then tour to the start from Owaka. Trailers may be left in Owaka (recommended) however there is room for trailers to be left on Centre Rd (before the McLennan bridge on the far left hand side of the road not obstructing members of the public.

Start – 10.30am (Drivers briefing), followed immediately by Indian file.

Classes - A 2WD 0 - 1300cc
 B 2WD 1301 - 1600cc
 C 2WD 1601 & over
 D 4WD

Competitor Requirements – Drivers must hold as a minimum a MSNZ **M** licence (ClubSport) and current membership of an MSNZ affiliated club (eg SOCC). Cars must carry a passenger - passengers do not require a MSNZ licence but must attend the competitors briefing and sign an indemnity form. All drivers and passengers shall wear safety apparel as specified in the driver safety regulations suitable for ralliesprints contained in Appendix Two Schedule A (MotorSport NZ Manual No 36).

Vehicles: Vehicles DO REQUIRE a current registration and WOF for touring, non-road legal cars will need to be towed or trailered back to the start line (touring is on non-closed roads).

Competition – The event will start with an Indian file followed by up to 4 official runs, time allowing, with your fastest run counting towards your result.

TWO DRIVER CARS: Provision is available for two driver cars, however it is solely the drivers responsibility to get the vehicle from the finish to the start in time for the second drivers run.

4. Entries

These are now open and will close at 5pm Thursday 12th August 2021. Late entries will be accepted if numbers allow closing at the end of documentation on the day of the event.

Entry Fee - \$150.00.

Puahoa Road before the start line or Centre Road before the Mclennan Bridge. **DO NOT BLOCK CENTRE ROAD.**

9. Prize giving

Will take place at the conclusion of the event at the Catlins Inn OWAKA.
